Just steps from majestic Lake Tahoe, Edgewood Tahoe offers an award-winning experience at the nexus of water, land, and perfection. Whether you are seeking adventure among the alpes or a rejuvenating retreat, the resort's incredible setting and impeccable aesthetic blur the lines between nature, art, and architecture. With a LEED silver certified mountain lodge, tranquil spa, and award-winning 18-hole championship golf course—along with a wide array of dining, shopping, and outdoor activity options—Edgewood Tahoe is the premier all-encompassing lakeside resort experience in Tahoe.

The Lodge at Edgewood Tahoe is home to 154 luxurious rooms and suites and was voted the #1 Resort Hotel in the U.S. in 2018 by readers of Travel + Leisure. All guests of the Lodge are treated to first-class accommodations including an in-room gas fireplace, terrace or balcony with seating area, premium linens and luxuries, and complimentary wifi internet. Guests also gain access to the year-round lakefront heated pool and hot tub, state-of-the-art fitness center, nightly s'mores gathering, morning *Après* Sleep cart offerings, and morning yoga class. Guests may also take advantage of a courtesy deluxe shuttle providing transportation to nearby destinations.

Edgewood Tahoe Golf Course, designed by George Fazio in 1968 and later renovated by Tom Fazio, offers the premier setting of a championship caliber golf experience with breathtaking views of the High Sierra. Challenging yet fair, the course offers a choice of four sets of tees, ranging in length from 5,343 yards to a demanding 7,529—providing a challenge for golfers of all skill levels. The Golf Course has been consistently selected by *Golf Digest* as one of "America's 100 Greatest Public Courses," and has attracted some of golf's greatest players, including Tiger Woods, Arnold Palmer, Phil Mickelson, John Daly, and Lee Trevino. Edgewood has played host to the USGA's 1980 US Public Links Championship and 1985 US Senior Open Championship, and has been the home to the annual American Century Celebrity Golf Championship since 1991. Edgewood has also specialized in hosting golf groups and tournaments of all sizes.

Edgewood Restaurant is South Lake Tahoe's greatest hidden gem. With stunning floor-to-ceiling windows and an elegant lodge atmosphere, diners enjoy striking views of mountains, pines, and the glistening sapphire lake while celebrating golden anniversaries and creating diamond memories. Conveniently located inside the Lodge is the **Bistro**, a full-service space open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner, Bistro serves as Edgewood's refined, yet casual, dining option for families, friends, and foodies alike. Sustainability & Philanthropy

"To be stewards of the land, guardians of the Lake, and solid corporate citizens of the communities in which we operate"

The fact we borrow this land from future generations is a fact that is not lost on us, which is why we remain committed to a continued legacy of land stewardship and environmental redevelopment. With every move we make, our number one focus is always on minimizing our environmental footprint and keeping this pristine area just as pristine for those who come after us, as it was for those who came before us.

Prior to breaking ground on The Lodge, Edgewood completed several "threshold" improvement projects including:

- Treating and removing 500,000 lbs. of sediment per year from Lake Tahoe via enhanced wetlands and deepened filtration settling ponds.
- Realignment and daylighting of Edgewood Creek to allow native fish passage and spawning habitat.
- Acquirement and demolition of several obsolete, environmentally unsustainable properties and restored the land to a natural state, creating a neighborhood park on one site.



LEED, or Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design, certification provides a framework to create healthy, highly efficient, and cost-saving green buildings, and is a globally recognized symbol of sustainability achievement. The Lodge at Edgewood Tahoe is a LEED silver certified building with the following achieved projects:

- Lake sourced cooling system, by extracting 43-degree water from Lake Tahoe, eliminating use of electrical to cool the water, reducing our carbon footprint.
- Use of locally sourced materials, such as the granite sourced from a local quarry, eliminating the impact of long distance shipping for those materials.
- Providing employee bike racks, employee shuttles, and employee locker room showers so that employees can bike and walk to work.
- Pedestrian and bike friendly pathways to local commercial areas to reduce vehicle traffic.

Additional Sustainable and Philanthropic Initiatives:

- Edgewood Tahoe happily offers 4 Tesla electric car charging stations and 2 other all-purpose charging stations for other popular electric car models.
- Edgewood Tahoe is a proud participating member of Clean the World. We donate all partially used soaps and other bottled amenities to this great organization so they may distribute them across the world to citizens who desperately need them due to impoverished conditions. Clean the World has a goal of saving one million lives each year through improvements related to hygiene.
- For the 2017 holiday season, Edgewood team members contributed two full SUVs worth of food and toys plus a monetary donation to Christmas Cheer, a local non-profit community outreach program.
- Before the Edgewood Tahoe golf course opened for its 50th season this year, Edgewood supported several local high schools by donating 316 rounds of golf for school fund raising tournaments. Whittell and South Tahoe High Schools booster clubs conducted a joint event at the course and raised approximately \$21,000 each over the two-day tournament.
- For the 2018 American Century Championship, Edgewood partnered with the Lake Tahoe Community College Foundation, Lake Tahoe Educational Foundation, and Tahoe-Douglas Rotary for 400 volunteer hours of service at Edgewood's four main concession tents around the golf course. All three organizations will receive a combined total over \$55,000 for program initiatives specific to education.
- At the end of each golf season, Edgewood hosts the Boys & Girls Club tournament which regularly raises approximately \$45,000 to \$55,000 for the club.
- In addition, Edgewood Companies donates over \$50,000 per year to local charities and civic organizations as well as supporting many charities with in-kind donations such as



overnight resort stays, rounds of golf or culinary offerings to help these charities raise much needed funds.

- Every year Edgewood donates \$1,000 college scholarships to one recipient at each of the local high schools—Douglas High School, George Whittell High School, and South Tahoe High School—to assist them with their continuing education expenses.
